Hello, from your new Rector, I am delighted to be joining you all. It is always hard to know how to describe myself, but here goes. I am married to Neil, with two adult children, Kathryn married to Luke and Aidan (AJ). I was born and brought up in Greater Manchester with my triplet older brothers. RIDE-ON GARDEN RAILWAYS

So I have tell you about one of my hobbies as an example.

My Ride-On Garden Railway, for the grandchildren, but all the adults usually want to drive the train too. A 5-inch wide ground level track, 1/12th scale. In most parks the track is either elevated on stilts and/or uses wider 7.25 inch gauge for fee-paying passengers.



Steam locomotives use real coalfired steam. Diesel models use car batteries with electric wheelchair motors which are more accessible and affordable. You only need one loco and coach or so I tell my wife, so it is not a more expensive than a large indoor model railway. I am building wagon kits and I would like a radio controlled model that I can set running around the track while I mow the lawn. You can build them

yourself, buy kits or complete models from specialist suppliers.

Southport Model Engineering Club has a track in Victoria Park and one day I will get a trailer to take my models down there for a longer run. There are other Clubs in neighbouring towns that have open days for visitors too. My track is a oval which fits in about 60x45 feet but it could fit in a smaller garden. I enjoy the civil engineering, building the railway and integrating it with the garden. Happy to help anyone thinking of building a railway. Anyone local have an interest in engineering with a small lathe in their workshop, I need small part making for a turntable?



NEWS FROM YOUR PARISH COUNCIL

Planning

2022/1266/FUL Meridien Cottage, 10 Halsall Lane, Halsall. Single Storey Extension.

2022/1324/FUL Erection of convenience store with associated access, car park and landscaping at Junction of Moss Road and Bentham's Way, Halsall. Applicant is James Hall and Co Ltd. Decision level – delegated to the Corporate Director of Place and community for determination unless a Member requests consideration by Planning Committee.

Report from Halsall Parish Council -Traffic & Road Safety Working Group

LCC Highways have responded via Andy Pratt, Deputy PCC, with the results of the detailed traffic analysis on Gorsuch Lane. As suggested by Sat Nav analysis there is no significant speeding problem on Gorsuch Lane. 85% of recorded speeds are below the speed limit.

Still waiting for further information from an FOI request from Lancashire Police on details of collisions. It is thought that collisions are the result of confusion over priorities at the junction rather than speed.

A further meeting with Andy Pratt and LCC Highways is scheduled for 1st February. There will be a Working Group pre-meeting arranged for last week in January.

More work to be done on creating a list of options for solar powered SPIDs for the next council meeting.

In the vacancy created by Cllr Young's resignation, Halsall Parish Council co-opted Cllr Noel McCarthy-Thomason and we welcome him to our team.

Flooding

Reports of road run-off flooding received due to heavy rainfall. Cllr. Timon will speak to LCC engineers regarding drain cleaning at these locations. Cllr Wright(s) reported that the New Cut Lane area drainage was much improved, due to the works carried out by Lancashire County Council, as large sections of road drains under New Cut Lane were replaced.



Gardener's Corner

February at-a-glance.

The first signs of spring are starting to appear if you don't mind going out to look for them! February is a subtle month with catkins and the first bulbs cautiously pushing their heads above the wintery earth, while keen gardeners desperately look for some real gardening to do. Happy gardening.

General Garden Tasks

Make new beds and borders

Finish off winter digging

Order plug plants

Prune certain types of clematis – refer to a good gardening book for exact advice

Renewal – prune old shrubs, deciduous hedges and climbers

Brush snow off conifers, large evergreens and hedges to avoid splaying or breaking

Move deciduous trees and shrubs (ideally do this in November or early March) Plant lily-of-the-valley crowns

Keep deadheading any winter flowering pansies or polyanthus in tubs and hanging baskets

Water and top-dress plants in year-round tubs and container grown herbs

Prepare soil ready for sowing, covering it with polythene sheeting to warm it up for early vegetables

Plan shallots and Jerusalem artichokes.

Prune autumn-fruiting raspberries now, and plant new canes between now and mid-march

Protect strawberries with horticultural fleece

Finish winter-pruning standard apple and pear trees

Ventilate the greenhouse at every opportunity, but water as little as you can get away with

Pot up stored dahlia tubers and lily bulbs

Spray fuchsias with water on fine days o start them back into growth

Chit potatoes if you didn't get chance last month

Take precautions to make sure your pond never freezes over entirely

Get-a-head

Prepare the greenhouse before the season gets fully underway -clean water storage barrels, watering cans, pots and seed trays, propagator and greenhouse glass.

Plants in their Prime

Hellebores, Hamamellis, Viburnum, Mahonia japonica, Sarcococca, Skimmia japonica `Rubella, Clematis `Freckles`, Jasmine, winter-flowering pansies, Saxifraga apiculata, Daphne mezereum, Abeliophyllum distichum (white forsythia), Sempervivums

Bulbs – Iris riticulata, Crocus, Narcissus (varieties) scilla, Anemone blanda
